

PRIVACY POLICY
FOR THE PURCHASE OF TICKETS FOR THE SERVICES OFFERED
BY THE ALEKSANDER JABŁOŃSKI FOUNDATION

According to Art. 13 sec. 1 and sec. 2 of the general regulation on the protection of personal data of April 27, 2016. we inform you that:

1. the administrator of your personal data is the Aleksander Jabłoński Foundation with its registered office in Toruń, at ul. Grudziądzka 5/7, hereinafter referred to as the Foundation.
2. In any case, you can contact the Data Protection Officer at the above-mentioned correspondence address with the note: Data Protection Inspector or by e-mail at the following e-mail address: kontakt@faj.org.pl.
3. Your personal data including: name and surname, e-mail address will be processed in order to conduct single and multiple purchases of tickets offered by the Foundation pursuant to art. 6 section 1 point b of the General Data Protection Regulation;
4. The recipients of personal data processed as part of the online booking system may be: suppliers of IT systems and IT services, entities providing the Foundation with accounting services, debt collection, legal, analytical and marketing services, operators of electronic payment systems and banks in the field of payment execution, authorized bodies to receive this personal data on the basis of legal provisions.
5. Transaction data, including personal data, may be transferred to "Polskie ePłatności" spółka z ograniczoną odpowiedzialnością with its registered office in Tajęcina (formerly "Paylane" sp. z oo), address: Tajęcina 113, 36-002 Jasionka, KRS: 0000227278, NIP 5862141089 and REGON 220010531 to the extent necessary to process payments for the order.
6. Personal data will be processed for the time necessary to perform all obligations arising from the sale of tickets. in case data personal data processed for the purpose of providing electronic services - for the duration of their provision or until the user's account is deleted.
7. You have the right to access your data and the right to rectify, delete, limit processing, the right to transfer data, the right to raise objections, the right to withdraw consent at any time without affecting the lawfulness of processing, which was made on the basis of consent before its withdrawal ;

8. You have the right to lodge a complaint with the President of the Personal Data Protection Office when you consider that the processing of your personal data violates the provisions of the General Data Protection Regulation of 27 April 2016;
9. Providing your personal data is a condition for the performance of the contract in order to purchase tickets. You are obliged to provide them, and the consequence of not providing personal data will be the inability to purchase tickets;
10. Your personal data will not be transferred to a third country;
